Personal data

Boutiquehotel The Church processes your personal data because you use our services and/or because you provide it to us yourself. Below you will find an overview of the personal data we process:

- Information about your activities on our website
- Payment details
- Purchase history

Boutiquehotel The Church processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Handling an agreement (eg. reservations)
- Payment transactions
- Guest satisfaction
- Sending our newsletter; if you have given permission for this
- Communication; to inform you about changes to our services/products
- To deliver goods and services to you
- Execution of legal obligation; information about our tax return

Special and/or sensitive personal data that we process:

Boutiquehotel The Church does not intend to collect data about website visitors under the age of 18. Unless they have permission from a parent or guardian. However, we cannot check whether a visitor is older than 18. We therefore advise parents to be involved in the online activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children from being collected without parental consent. Automated decision making

Boutiquehotel The Church does not make decisions based on automated processing on matters that can have (significant) consequences for people. These are decisions taken by computer programs or systems, without a person (for example an employee of Boutiquehotel The Church) being involved.

Store personal data

Boutiquehotel The Church does not store your personal data longer than is (legally) necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected.

Sharing personal data with third parties

Boutiquehotel The Church only provides personal data to third parties and only if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation or a legitimate interest. We conclude a processing agreement with companies that process your data on our behalf to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. Boutiquehotel The Church remains responsible for these processing operations.

Cookies

Boutiquehotel The Church only uses technical and functional cookies and analytical cookies that do not infringe your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit the website.

The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and, for example, remember your preferred settings. We can also use this to optimize our website. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all information previously saved via the settings of your browser.

- We have concluded a processor agreement with Google
- We have masked the last octet of the IP address
- We have turned off 'sharing data'
- We do not use other Google services in combination with the Google cookies.

The Boutiquehotel The Church website uses a reliable SSL certificate to ensure that your personal data does not fall into the wrong hands.

View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. You also have the right to withdraw your consent to the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Boutiquehotel The Church. You also have the right to data portability. This means

that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data we hold about you in a computer file to you or another organization mentioned by you. You can send a request for inspection, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for withdrawal of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to: privacy@hotelvillaruimzicht.nl.

To ensure that the request for inspection has been made by you, we ask you to enclose a copy of your proof of identity with the request. Make your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and citizen service number (BSN) black in this copy. This is to protect your privacy.

We will only use this information for the purpose for which it was provided and destroy it after inspection. We will respond to your request as quickly as possible, but at the latest within four weeks. We would also like to point out that you have the option of submitting a complaint to the national supervisory authority, the Dutch Data Protection Authority. You can do that [here](#).

How we secure personal data

Boutiquehotel The Church takes the protection of your data very seriously and takes appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorized changes. If you have the impression that your data is not properly secured or if there are indications of misuse, please contact privacy@hotelvillaruimzicht.nl.

Camera security

Boutiquehotel The Church has provided its building with clearly visible cameras with the aim of protecting the safety of our employees, guests and property and providing support in the event of calamities. When you enter our site, you will also be alerted to the presence of cameras. Boutiquehotel The Church stores camera images for a maximum of 28 days. In case of a valid reason (e.g. police investigation) camera images are kept longer, but not longer than necessary.
